Problem





The Homepage is central hub of the GreenHero game App, offering users an interface to access all of its features:


- 1) On the page you are introduced to our character, Lila.

Users can choose between Easy, Mid, and Hard Levels.


There are different sections of quest: Animal, Ocean, Plants, and Carbon Dioxide related quests.

Quest Board- Characters











After picking one, users will have the option to go back and pick a new one with the "back button."
